Voting will take place for two purposes:

Proposed 2023/2024	 To vote on the proposed Library Budget for 2023-2024 fiscal year, and To elect one Trustee.
\$ 232,700	To vote in the Library Election you must be a U.S. citizen 18 years of age or older; have been a resident of the Babylon School District for at least 30 days prior to the vote; and be registered to vote with either the School District or the Suffolk County Board of Elections.
\$ 189,850 \$ 990,000	Voter registration – Residents not yet registered to vote for the Library Budget and Trustee Election may do so in the School District Clerk's Office at the Babylon Junior-Senior High School, 50 Railroad Ave., Babylon Village, up to and including April 13, 2023 on days when school
\$ 990,000	is in session.

\$ 485, 985	If you cannot vote in person, you may be eligible to vote absentee. Remember that filing for an absentee ballot is a multi-step process: application, ballot, vote.
