Registration in all departments begins on Saturday, June 29th – be there or be square! Our amazing librarian team will be heading into the schools shortly to talk about the schedule, programs, reading logs, and prizes!

Over the later part of the Summer, you will notice work crews at the library, who will be putting a new roof on the building. We do not anticipate this construction to cause any building delayed openings or closures. We will keep you abreast as construction unfolds. Thank you in advance for your patience.

You will also see the new Babylon Public Library website unveiled by August 1st. The new website is more user friendly, with new features, such as our Library Market Program Calendar, which will allow you to register and pay online for specific programs. We will have a virtual reference chat, so you can interact with our librarians through any of your smart devices.

The Friends of the Library will be on Summer break until September 2024 – stay tuned for their Fall schedule in the next newsletter. WHY DO MOST LIBRARY PROGRAMS REQUIRE REGISTRATION?

- Program presenters often require a minimum number of attendees. If we don't have that number, we have to cancel the program.
- Most programs require supplies or offer snacks. The library purchases enough for registrants and may not have extras for walk-ins.
- If patrons register and don't show up, we still have to pay our presenters. Many programs have a waitlist - please let us know if you can't make it!

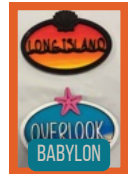

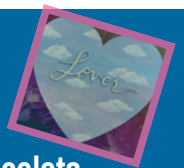

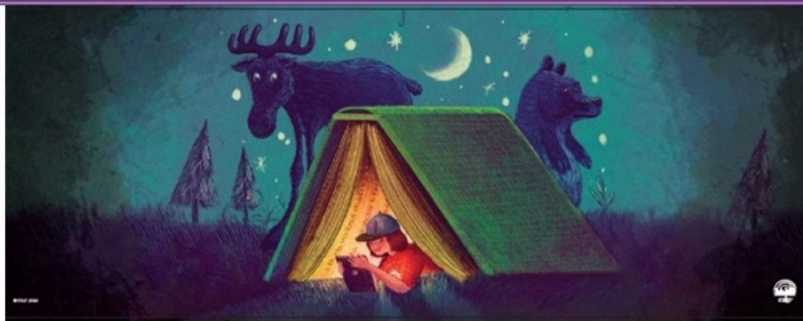
