## ANNUAL LIBRARY BUDGET VOTE

Tuesday, April 9, 2024 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. at the Babylon Public Library

Voting will take place for two purposes:

- 1. To vote on the proposed Library Budget for 2024-2025 fiscal year, and
- 2. To elect one Trustee.

To vote in the Library Election you must be a U.S. citizen 18 years of age or older; have been a resident of the Babylon School District for at least 30 days prior to the vote; and be registered to vote with either the School District or the Suffolk County Board of Elections.

Voter registration – Residents not yet registered to vote for the Library Budget and Trustee Election may do so in the School District Clerk's Office at the Babylon Junior-Senior High School, 50 Railroad Ave., Babylon Village, up to and including April 4, 2024 on days when school is in session.

To verify your registration status, please call the School District Clerk at 893-7923.

## **Absentee Ballots**

If you cannot vote in person, you may be eligible to vote absentee. Remember that filing for an absentee ballot is a multi-step process:

application, ballot, vote.

- Applications for absentee ballots can be obtained at the Library, 24 South Carll Ave., Babylon; or at the School District Clerk's Office, 50 Railroad Ave., Babylon Village; or online at the Library's website:

   www.babylonlibrary.org
- 2. Completed absentee ballot applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter; or one day before if personally delivered to the voter.
- 3. Absentee ballots must be returned no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 9, 2024 to the School District Clerk. It may be returned by someone other than the voter.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Debt service represents the amount due this fiscal year to repay our capital improvement bond. The bond was approved by the voters of the Babylon Library District in October 2002, for the expansion project.
