

FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Except as provided by law, the use of video camera, movie cameras, cell phone cameras, still cameras, tape recorders or other similar media devices on Library ground is prohibited without prior written approval obtained from the Library. Library staff may require the termination of any filming or photographing that violates this policy or appears to compromise public safety or security or interferes with the operation of Library.

Any person who has been permitted to film, video, record or photograph on Library grounds has sole responsibility for gaining permission/release from persons who they are filming, videoing, recording or photographing.

Pictures taken by Library

Library staff or designees may film, video, record or photograph Library programs for use in Library publicity. Any individual who objects to filming, videoing, recording or photographing of themselves or their child(ren) or minor(s) in their legal charge shall so notify the Library in writing sufficiently in advance to allow for arrangements to be made, if practicable. The Library reserves the right to proceed with such filming, videoing, recording and photographing, in which case the individual may opt out of the program.
